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**Access**

As the owner of the well identified above (Well) and / or the owner of the property on which the Well is located (Property), I hereby authorize Shandon San Juan Water District (District) personnel and the District’s representatives to enter the Property to survey the location of the Well and measure the groundwater level in the Well under the condition that the District indemnifies and holds me harmless from all claims for, or on account of, any physical injuries to persons or property caused solely by any negligent act or omission to act by the District or its representatives while on the Property.

**Use of Well Data**

I hereby further authorize the District to use data collected from this well to compare and contrast existing wells for the purpose of determining relative hydrologic connectivity between wells within the District Boundaries. It is understood that at the end of the study a separate agreement will be made with those owners of wells selected for inclusion for long term monitoring. During this study period the District and its Consultant Engineer will hold this data solely for the purpose of this study.

I understand that for purposes of the consent granted herein, Well data includes the following data related to the Well:

- Water level measurements
- State Well Number
- Well construction details from the Well Completion Report or other sources
- GPS coordinates of the location
- Well use / type (e.g. domestic, irrigation, monitoring)

**Public Record**

Owner acknowledges that the information that District develops or receives pursuant to this Consent will be used in connection with the implementation of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (“SGMA”) (Water Code § 10720 *et seq.*) and may constitute a disclosable public record under the terms of the California Public Records Act (Government Code § 6250 *et seq.*). District expressly disclaims any guarantee of confidentiality of such information; however, District agrees that District and its contractors will exercise commercially reasonable efforts to aggregate such information in a manner that will not expressly attribute any particular information to Owner.

The authorization provided herein supersedes any prior authorization(s) (including any limitations thereto) granted to the District in connection with the Well and shall apply to any and all Well data, including data collected pursuant to any such prior authorization(s).
