# IX. Update on Projects

Director Cunha reported that GSI is working to combine the results of the Paso Basin Aerial Groundwater Mapping Poly Study data with their own data to develop a 3-D model as an effective tool to show potential for active recharge projects. GSI will present a draft of the model at the next SSJWD Board meeting.

Director Cunha reported that SSJWD has received comment letters from the SWRCB regarding the District's applications to appropriate water and is currently working with legal counsel and consulting engineers to develop a formal response to submit by the deadline of June 3, 2021. Director Cunha reminded everyone that the State's lengthy review process is just getting underway and SSJWD will continue to provide updates at appropriate milestones.
