SHANDON-SAN JUAN GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY

RESOLUTION 21-004 REGARDING GSA BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, following formation of the Shandon-San Juan Water District, the District adopted Resolution 17-003, pursuant to which the District's Board of Directors elected to form the Shandon-San Juan Groundwater Sustainability Agency (the "GSA");

WHEREAS, following adoption of Resolution 17-003, the District undertook such measures as were necessary and appropriate under the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (Water Code § 10720 et seq.) (SGMA) to establish the GSA as the exclusive GSA for the portion of the Paso Robles Area Groundwater Subbasin (DWR Bulleting 118 Basin No. 3-004.06) (the "Basin") that is situated within the District's boundaries;

WHEREAS, the GSA, together with other Groundwater Sustainability Agencies within the Basin, and pursuant to a coordination agreement by and among them, submitted to the Department of Water Resources (DWR) for review the Paso Robles Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Plan (the "GSP");

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2021, the San Luis Obispo County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) caused to be recorded in the Official Records of San Luis Obispo County as Document No. 2021052091 a *Certificate of Completion*, pursuant to which certain lands detached from the District (the "Detachment"); and

WHEREAS, as a result of the Detachment the GSA no longer has jurisdiction over the detached lands, including for purposes of implement and enforcing SGMA and the GSP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The GSA acknowledges the Detachment and considers the detached lands that are the subject of the *Certificate of Completion* referenced above to fall within the jurisdiction of San Luis Obispo County for purposes of SGMA, pursuant to Water Code § 10724; and
- 2. The president of the GSA Board of Directors and GSA staff are hereby authorized to undertake such actions as may be necessary and appropriate in light of the changes to the GSA's jurisdictional boundaries that are the result of the Detachment, including coordinating with other Groundwater Sustainability Agencies in Basin and DWR to make such revisions to the GSP as DWR might require.
