# 2021 General Election – November 2, 2021

SSJWD will hold a general election on November 2, 2021. Directors Sinton, Miller, and Peck currently occupy and hold three seats on the District's Board of Directors, and their terms are set to expire at noon on December 3, 2021. The legal notice will be published in New Times SLO on July 15, 2021.

SSJWD filed a Notice of Elective Office and Boundary map with the County of SLO on June 30, 2021. Declarations of Candidacy forms are available on the District's website beginning July 12, 2021 and are due no later than 5pm on August 6, 2021. To be qualified, a candidate must be over the age of 18 years and either a holder of title to land within the District or the legal representative of a holder of title to land within the District.
